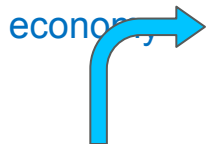

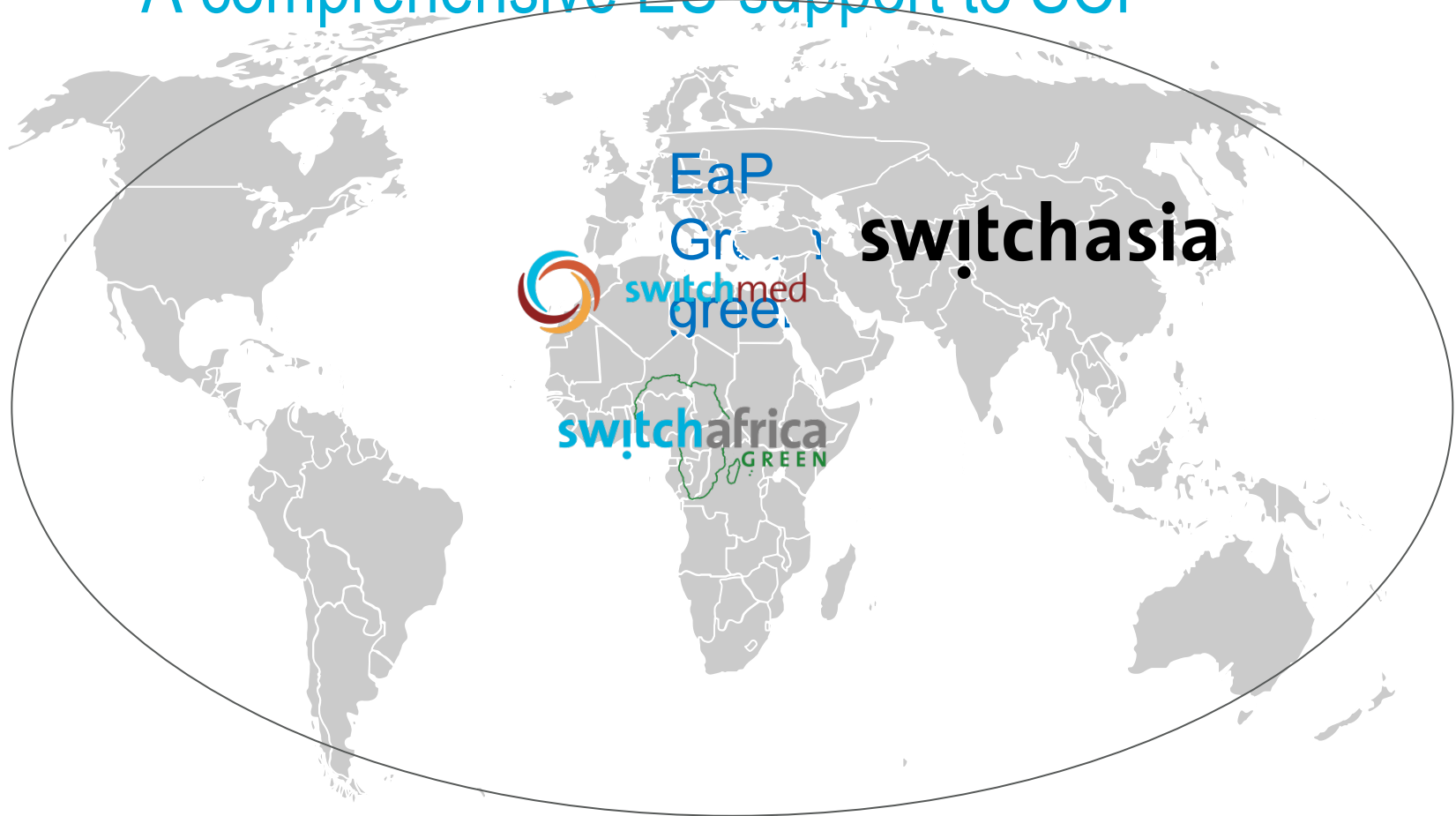

Programme development 2008-2014

- **SWITCH-Asia is an EU-financed grant programme supporting the adoption of Sustainable Consumption and Production Practices in Asia**
 - Resulting from 5 competitive calls for proposals 81 Projects received supporting grants of about 1.7 mil in average
 - Total about € 150 mil. Disbursed as grants

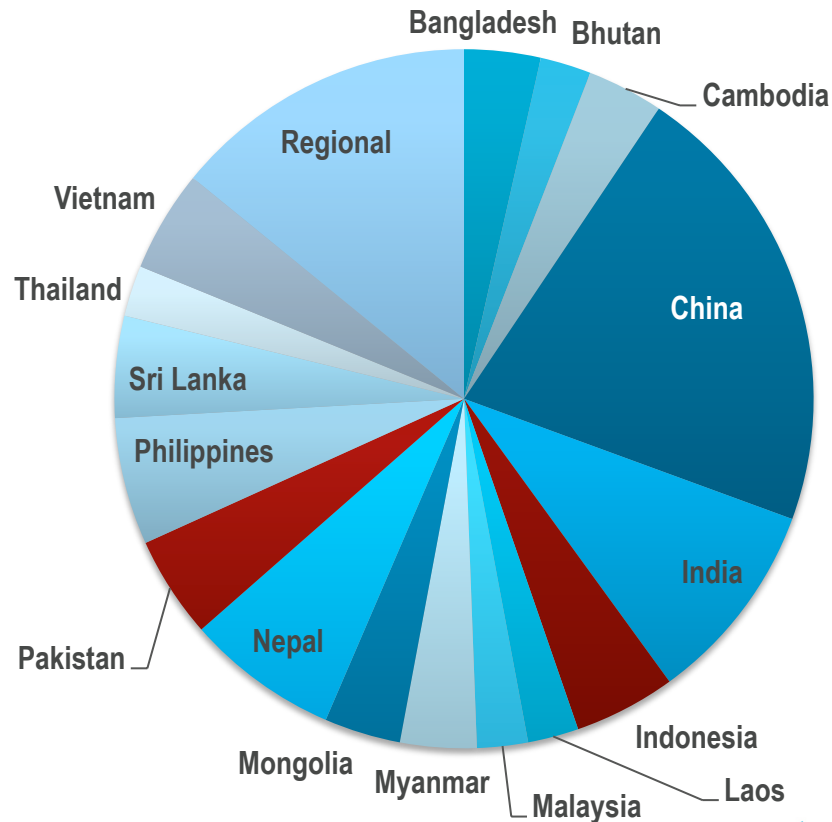
SWITCH-Asia Phase II 2014 - 2020

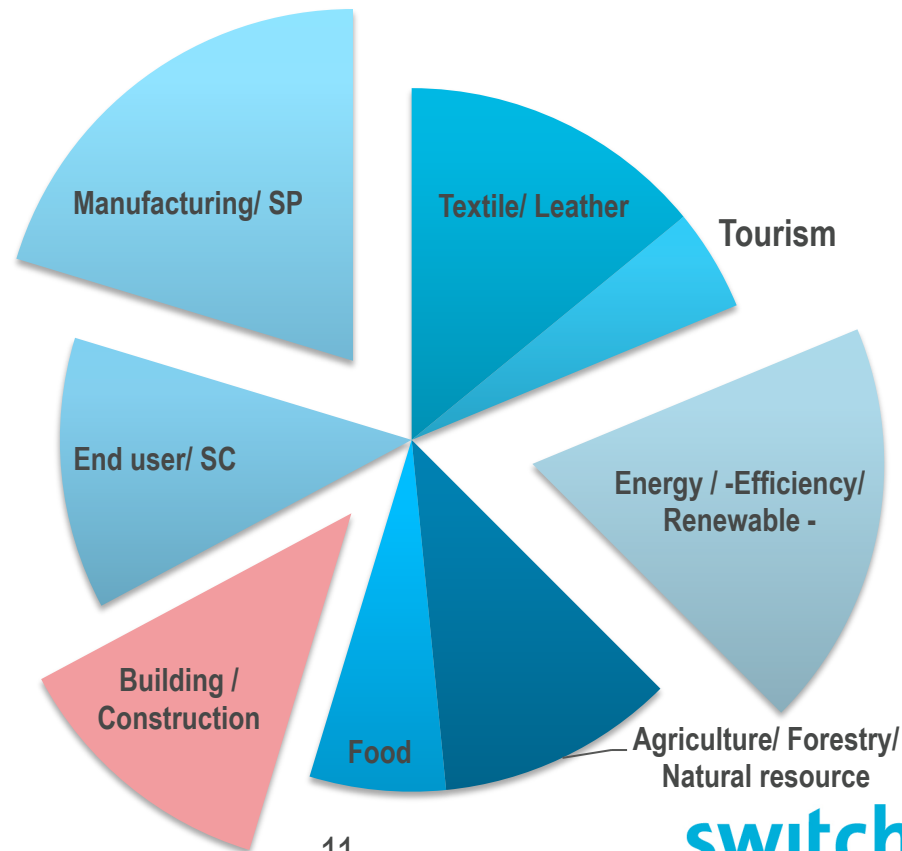
Regional distribution of SWITCH-Asia projects



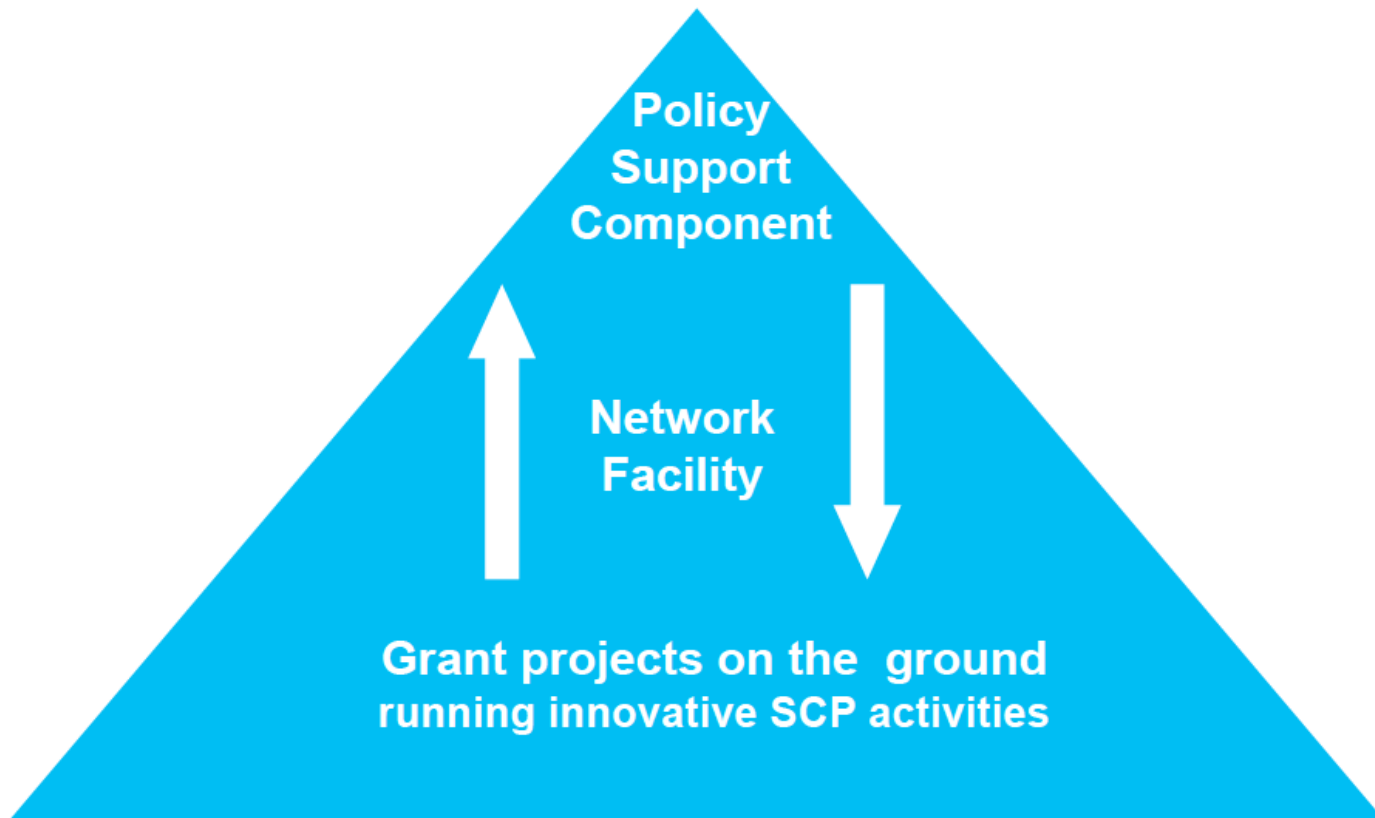
