- Attendees learn the basics of founding startups and launching successful ventures










# How ADRAITinn Startup Weekends are performed





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#### Co-labs



- Collaborative workplaces (co-labs) are addressed to individuals (freelancers or potential entrepreneurs), SMEs, startups...
  - in the collaborative workspace the new SMEs will be able to settle, work, meet and exchange ideas and experiences with other start-ups, invite potential customers, hold meetings, attend workshops, lectures and presentations.







#### Co-labs



- Collaborative workplaces (co-labs) are addressed to individuals (freelancers or potential entrepreneurs), SMEs, startups...
  - The environment is supported by electronic communications and groupware which enable participants to overcome space and time differentials.
  - There will be organized events that will address identified market and societal needs through R&D









### **Help Desks**



- Spin-offs and start-ups have needs ranging from Office Space to IPR handling. Help desk will offer:
  - help in the collaborative workspace
  - information about Pre-seed Funding opportunities and Resources to support new business
  - services: Accounting, Legal, both supported by external experts.









## Mentoring



- Mentors experienced businessmen and women which will help SMEs executives identify strengths, weakness, opportunities and threats,
  - will work with SMEs on a one-to-one basis and provide support in strategy, finance, people;
  - will provide advice, expertise, experience and knowledge, thus enabling SMEs figure out how to create sustainable growth and competitive advantages for the company even on an international scale;
